Easter is a spring festival and a Christian festival. In the UK, children have got a two-week holiday at Easter time. Many people go away on holiday or visit family.





Different places in the UK have got different Easter traditions. In Preston, in the north-west of England, people go to the park on Easter Monday and roll eggs. They use a chocolate egg or a real, cooked egg. It's important to decorate your egg so that you can find it again!



There's special Easter food, too. People traditionally eat hot cross buns on Good Friday, the Friday before Easter Sunday. They're a kind of cake that you eat with butter. On Easter Sunday, children get chocolate eggs with sweets inside. The traditional lunch for Easter Sunday is roast lamb.





